- ❖ Prepare to take a multiple-choice and short-answer (written response) exam over the book you chose! It's that simple!
  - **There is NO use of any notes or the book while you test**
  - You will have the entire period to take the exam
  - The exam will be around 20 multiple-choice questions and two short-answer questions

Everyone enrolled in the course will take the multiple choice exam in class on **Friday, August 18th**, which is the second day of school. **NO EXCUSES!**
