The NROTC Scholarship Program offers students the opportunity to earn their degree and receive valuable leadership and management skills while enjoying the benefits of an exciting career. The basic requirements and benefits of this outstanding program are listed below.

1. Selected applicants receive:

- Full tuition and other financial benefits. NROTC Units are located at over **153** of the nation's leading colleges and universities. (see page 2 for more info on room and board)
- \$250-\$400 a month tax-free spending money.

2. Basic eligibility requirements:

- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Be at least 17 years of age and not older than 23 by September 1st<sup>h</sup> of the year you start college
- Complete high school/equivalent certificate
- Take the ACT or SAT test prior to deadline and receive at least the minimum scores listed below:

**ACT**  
**Math = 21**  
**English = 22**  
**Combined 44**

**SAT**  
**Math = 540**  
**Critical Reading = 550**  
**Combined 1100**

**MISR applicant**  
**Must have minimum**  
**scores in math/English**  
**cumulative not required.**

3. May apply for one of these options:

- NAVY (cannot apply for both Navy and Marine option)
- NURSE CORPS (must major in a nursing degree program leading to a BSN)
- Two and Three Year option available for current High school graduates currently in college.

4. Degree requirements:

- Major in **any** field
- Take normal course load required for degree
- Enroll in two Naval Science Courses per year
- Complete the following courses: \*Calculus, \*Physics, \*Computer Science (1 term), \*National Security Policy/U.S. Military Affairs, English Grammar and Composition \*Not required for Nurse.

5. Military Service requirements:

- **No obligation for first year of college**
- Upon completion of degree, receive commission as Ensign in the Navy Reserve
- Five year active duty obligation (Except Nurse NROTC Four years.)

6. Benefits of NROTC:

- Free college tuition
- 100% employment upon graduation
- Opportunity to lead and manage personnel
- Unlimited travel opportunities
- 30 days paid vacation earned annually
- Excellent medical/dental benefits

Completing the application does not obligate you in any way. You may dis-enroll from the NROTC program at any time during the freshman year without incurring any service obligation or financial penalty.

**Final Deadline to submit is Jan 31<sup>st</sup>. Apply early to go in front of first boards in October and November.**

## NROTC Minority Serving Institution (MSI) Scholarship Program OPTION

The NROTC has a limited number of scholarships available for students to attend MSI schools, which encompass Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU), High Hispanic Enrollment (HHE) schools, and other Minority Serving Institutions (MSI).

If you are interested in attending one of the schools listed below, you must respond positively to the MSISR question and list at least one of the MSI schools in your top 5 choices on your national scholarship application in order for the application to be processed.

### Eligibility Criteria

Applicants may be of any gender, race, or ethnic background.

Must meet all Navy-Option NROTC Scholarship eligibility requirements (see [Requirements](#) on website) as well as:

- Must be a Navy Option applicant (Marine Corps and Nurse Corps Option applicants are not eligible).
- Must receive an Officer Interview from any NROTC Commanding Officer or Navy Talent Acquisition Group (NTAG) Commanding Officer.
- Valid Test Dates for the 2024 Scholarship Year are Dec 2019 to Dec 2023.
- Qualifying scores on Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or American College Test (ACT):

### **SAT: 540 Math; 550 Verbal/Critical Reading**

*SAT Combined score of 1100 is NOT REQUIRED for MSI Scholarship*

*If Combined test score below 1100, must respond positively to the MSISR interest question in the application in order for application to be processed*

**OR**

### **ACT: 21 Math; 22 English**

*ACT Combined score of 44 is NOT REQUIRED for MSI Scholarship*

*If combined test score below 44, must respond positively to the MSISR interest question in the application in order for application to be processed*

- Any combination of scores, regardless of test type, can be utilized to achieve the minimum test scores of each category.
- Applicants must list at least one MSI school with an affiliated NROTC program in their top 5 choices on the national scholarship application.
- Applicants must be admitted to the MSI in order to use their scholarship if selected.

### Application Timeline

**No later than 31 January 2024**

- Complete on-line NROTC National Scholarship on-line application.
- All other timelines for the national scholarship application apply.

### Application Process

Complete the on-line application (same as the regular application, check the MSISR option).

- Work with your NROTC Coordinator to ensure the application is completely processed and ready for board consideration.

Work with your NROTC Coordinator to schedule an Officer Interview with any NROTC Commanding Officer or NTAG Commanding Officer.

If interested, contact the NROTC Unit at the MSI you wish to attend for further information.
