How did this committee originate?

- In the Fall of 2021 the AISD Bond & Growth Planning Committee met seven times over a four-month period to put together a comprehensive bond package which included 2 elementary schools, 1 middle school, technology, transportation, and updates at other facilities.
- The committee recognized the need for the elementary and middle school facilities and included those in the bond package. But the question about what the high school configuration would be continued to be a discussion topic that the committee felt the community wanted direction about before the bond election in May 2022.



HIGH SCHOOL ADVISORY & PLANNING COMMITTEE 2022

- The decision was made by the Bond & Growth Planning Committee to return the **191 S Highway 377 campus** currently being used as a middle school to a future high school facility.
- No alignment decisions were made about the high school.
- The 377 campus was first used as a 6-12 facility from 1999-2008. In the fall of 2008, 6th graders began attending Argyle Intermediate along with 5th graders from Hilltop Elementary.
- In 2016 MS moved to Phase I at Canyon Falls and HS continued at 377.
- Fall 2016-Spring 2021 HS was located at 191 South Highway 377.



WHAT MAKES 191 SOUTH HIGHWAY 377 A HIGH SCHOOL FACILITY?

- The school was built to accommodate HS students. The amenities include:
- Auditorium
- Large band hall & percussion hall
- Stadium and track
- Girls' and visitors' field house
- Indoor Activity Center
- Baseball and softball competition fields
- Black box for theatre



WHAT MAKES 191 SOUTH HIGHWAY 377 A HIGH SCHOOL FACILITY?

- These amenities are not generally built for a middle school.
- Currently the 377 campus has functional capacity for 1,150 students. Argyle High School in Canyon Falls has capacity for 1,750 students. That totals 2,900 students.
- We need space for 3,900 students within 10 years.
